Chief Apostle & Overseer Margaret L. Moore is a native of Mobile, Alabama, but spent most of her young and adult life in Sacramento, California. She was born and raised in a strict Holy and God fearing home environment, where both parents were called of God. She received Christ and was filled with the Holy Spirit at the age of ten. Upon the leading of the Holy Spirit she moved to Atlanta, Georgia in 1992, where she now resides. Chief Apostle Margaret L. Moore is the founder of the Anointing Full Gospel Center (1999), located in Conyers, Georgia. She carries an unusual and powerful Apostolic Anointing upon her life, as she has been gifted and anointed to walk in all five of the Ascending Offices. She was called to be Teacher (1985), Evangelist (1989), Pastor (1998), Prophetic Anointing (2002), Apostle (2007) and Chief (Apostle) & Overseer (2009). She is the Chief Overseer of fourteen Ministries, in which two of these are International. She is the Founder of Moore & More Ministries (3M Anointed Ministry), Anointed Women's Ministries of Atlanta (1998), Rachel's Ministries, Women of Hope Ministries (2000), A Holy Ministerial Alliance, One Faith Ministerial Alliance International (2001), and Real Talk/Real People Radio Ministry of Atlanta (2009). She is an authenticated Apostle called by God who preaches the unadulterated gospel of Jesus Christ, with the evidence of miracles, healing, deliverance, signs and wonders.

The Scripture promise to her is Isaiah 60:1. "Arise, shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee". This is not just a woman, but an Anointed Woman of God who is led by the Spirit and has come with a message from God for such a time as this!

Spotlight on Ministry

~ Alabama Street Evangelism ~

Luke 14:23 says, and he said unto the servant, "Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled." And we went! On May 23, 2014, as the mandate was given to our Leader, Chief Apostle & Overseer, Margaret L. Moore in her obedience to God, selected a AFGC Evangelism Team and set out to Montgomery, Alabama. Not knowing where they were going, they went! The church collected all types of personal items for both men and women, along with Bibles, and they took the Gospel to the streets. The first stop was in a dark corner of a gas station where they ministered to a young man who sat on-side of the curve hurting, broken, hopeless, lost, and without spiritual direction. Others came from among the trees and bushes, addicted to alcohol and drugs. They were also ministered to about Christ and were introduced to his saving grace through Salvation. As the Word of God from Romans 10:9 was shared they were arrested by the Holy Spirit and the fallow ground of their hearts was broken up, as they lifted their hands and received Christ in their lives. After such a miraculous invitation it was evident that those men did not leave the same way they came, and it was in Jesus' name. Upon departure the Team was led by the Holy Spirit to the rough side of town, where twelve men and two women were standing on the streets. Some were drinking and others depressed with their lives,

lonely, unloved, un-groomed, and un-bathed. They too were ministered Christ and every person willingly lifted their hands, all simultaneously, confessing their sins, believing Christ would deliver them, accepted Him into their lives and were saved. Upon departing from that site they drove to another side of town where prostitutes hung-out. There they found a group of women all sitting around in chairs drinking alcohol and playing loud music. The Evangelism Team pulled up where they were, got out of their car, and began witnessing Christ. These women were confused, void in their lives, and in despair. There were no "condemnations", but the love of Christ that reached out to them. As, the Holy Spirit began to prick their hearts their lives were changed. The drinking stopped and the music halted. One young lady confessed that the desire to drink was gone. The prayers of deliverance, healing and wholeness were heard and the love of God saturated their hearts. Before departing they asked if Evangelism would come back again soon. They were excited about inviting other women to hear the Gospel of Christ, to know Jesus, find and receive him in their hearts as they themselves had done. They were assured that the Gospel of Jesus Christ would be brought back to their area again. Afterward, the Spirit spoke to Chief Apostle and gave her direction to return to the first location again. Surprisingly, there appeared a young man who had come to Christ a year prior,

when Chief Apostle Moore and Evangelist Joyce Hairston were mandated to travel to Montgomery, Alabama, and it was there this young man by the name of Jerrod was prayed for and ministered to about Jesus Christ. They had prayed continuously over a year that God's Spirit would lead them once again to see him, know his where about and follow up on his spiritual life. That prayer was answered! As Chief Apostle followed God's lead it was at that very location they found Jerrod once again. It was God's Amazing Grace! At that very sight, there were other men who came from among the trees who were prayed for, witnessed too and received Christ in their lives as well. Even under the influence, Jerrod remembered those two women who a year prior had loved up on him, received him as a son without judging or condemning, and brought Christ into his life. He asked permission to pray, and it was out of the depth and hollow place of his heart that he confessed his sins once again and received the love of God in his life. The harvest is ripe for Montgomery, Alabama and we invite all who will obey the command of Jesus, to go. We're asking those who know the Word of Prayer to continue praying for the souls that were gathered, and for all those in whom Christ will bring, as we take the Gospel to the world.

A Vision Comes True

The beginning of January, 2014 another Vision of our Chief Apostle & Overseer, Margaret L Moore has come true. Her Vision from the Gospel of Luke 14:23 says, Then the master told his servant, "Go out to the roads and country lanes and compel them to come in."

In June, 2013 she was lead by the Holy Spirit, after an invitation from the Rockdale Youth Detention Center, to initiate a Bible Study Program for young men who were incarcerated. As a result, she was asked to become a member of the Advisory Board of the Facility, and work with them in helping to aid and assist with various programs that would prepare these youth for entering back into main-stream society. By giving them the proper skills needed, the opportunity afforded could change their direction and lead them into greater paths towards greater opportunities for their lives. She took the challenge and began presenting workable ideas and positive ways to enhance the spiritual lives of these young men by providing twice a month Bible Study teachings within the facility. She recognized that change starts from the inside and then reflects outwardly. She began teaching the true Word of God, along with Elder Margaret A. Walker and Evangelist Joyce Hairston. Together, they focus on teaching the simplicity of the word that can change and re-shape the lives of these youth. Bible Study teachings, by Chief Apostle Margaret L. Moore, provides them with knowledge and understanding in knowing how to begin their lives again with a new and fresh perspective. Like Nicodemus, they could receive a new birth experience that would change their lives forever. Knowing Jesus, they began to see themselves differently by believing they could become everything God has pre-destined, determined, and called them to be. Isaiah 61:1 was given to Chief Apostle by God in understanding the mandate upon her life. "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because He has anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and the opening of the prison to them that are bound". January, 2014 the doors were opened

for Chief Apostle to bring the Gospel to young men between the ages of 12 to 16. At first, they came with hard, tough, and un-interesting looks, but as the teachings progressed their demeanor changed, the tough looks became humbling, and the harden hearts became soften as the Holy Spirit changed their lives.

St. Matthew 13:30 says, "Let the tare and wheat grow together until harvest, and I will say to the reapers, gather ye together first the tare, and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn". Approximately six to eight months later before their release, these young men walked out with new spiritual insight, new expectation and new direction. During, these months of what God had placed within them, they now had the opportunity to share with others their own personal experience of knowing how to understand the Word of God and by practicing it in their lives. A true turnaround was seen within the hearts of these young men. Not only did they change, but the employees of the Detention Facility changed as well. As the Anointing Full Gospel Center walk with the Visions of God and our Leader, run with understanding and excitement with a willing heart, nothing can stop the work of the Lord. The Gospel should never start and stop within the four walls of the church, but it must be carried to those who have lost their way, and to those who don't know the saving power of Jesus Christ. "If the Gospel of Christ be hidden it is hidden to those who are lost." The mandate has been placed, the season ordered, and the time has come where we must carry the Good-news of Jesus Christ to the community, the streets and to the world. Souls must be gathered, un-reachable reached, so that darkness can become light and the house of God be filled with his Glory. Let us start and not stop, get up when we are tired, PUSH when we get weary, and pray until we see something happen. Without Vision, a church, a city, a country and even a nation will perish. We have Vision from God, and we will run with it!
